

The General Data Protection Rules (GDPR)

You may be aware that the new General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) was approved by the EU Parliament on 14 April 2016 and will be enforced from 25 May 2018. GDPR will remain part of the Laws of the United Kingdom after we leave the EU.

You currently receive our newsletters and other patient focused information because you signed up to receive them via our website:-

These emails usually provide you with a link back to our website where you can view/download the relevant newsletter or bulletin.

Our website is maintained by “My Surgery Website” and the details you enter on it are held securely and encrypted within the UK. These details may include your name, your email address and possibly a mobile number.

My Surgery Website is the “Data Controller” for the information held about you on its website. Your data cannot be accessed by anyone who is not authorised to do so, and is only used for sending you details of Holly Tree Surgery’s newsletters and bulletins. There is no link between this data set and your medical records.

We hope that you will want to continue to receive our newsletters and bulletins. However, should you wish to remove yourself from the mailing list at any time you can simply click on the “unsubscribe” link at the bottom of this email or any subsequent emails that you receive.
